

## ASSINIBOIA MINOR BALL ASSOCIATION REGISTRATION INFORMATION

All registrations will be done online. There are two ways of doing this:

**Option 1: Register online anytime until March 18, 2017.**

**Option 2: Attend the in-person registration night on March 22, 2017.**

Please note that there is an **additional fee of \$20** for registrations **after March 30**. Also note that April 15 is the deadline to register. After that, there is no guarantee that we can accept additional players.

### Option 1: On-Line Registration

1. You will register your players online with either SoftballSask or Sask Baseball.. The link is on the Town of Assiniboia website.  
**ALL PLAYERS THAT REQUIRE UNIFORMS MUST PICK UP UNIFORMS AND DROP OFF UNIFORM DEPOSIT CHEQUES ON Wednesday, March 22, 2017. Assiniboia Composite High School Computer Lab.**
  - All players born 2009-2010-2011-2012-2013 will register with softball regardless of gender. This is **rally cap, pre-rally cap and tykes age group and they play co-ed. These players do not require uniforms.**
  - Players born 2008 and earlier who wish to play **BASEBALL (traditionally boys' baseball) require uniforms.**
  - Players born 2008 and earlier who wish to play **SOFTBALL (traditionally girls' softball/fastpitch) require uniforms.**
2. There are three options for payment:
  - a. *Online* with visa or mastercard.
  - b. *E-transactions* with Conexus Credit Union:

## **Additional Important Information:**

1. Uniform pick up and Registration: March 22, 2017 at Assiniboia Composite High School 4:30-8:30pm.
2. Please note that there is an **additional fee of \$20** for registrations **after March 30**.
3. Also note that April 15 is the deadline to register. After that, there is no guarantee that we can accept additional players.
4. Uniform deposits of \$100 per player (**separate post-dated cheques per player**) are required for **all but** the Tykes, Pre-Rally Cap and Rally Cap.
5. For safety and hygiene reasons we advise all players to purchase their own batting helmet. It is wise to purchase the face mask at the same time. It is mandatory in most softball and some baseball leagues.
6. When teams are made, coaches will contact you regarding practice times and days.
7. The ball typically flies off an aluminum bat at a much higher rate of speed than a wooden bat. For player safety, baseball is generally moving away from the use of aluminum bats. It is already mandatory for certain leagues and some provincial playoffs. As Sask. Baseball moves to wooden bats only, AMBA will not be providing wooden bats for players. Please be prepared for that.  
*AMBA does not require this at this time.*

**Each player from Mosquito, Mites, Squirts, Pee Wee, Bantam and Midget are required to buy their own WHITE ball pants. Western Cycle in Regina is giving 15% off when you purchase there.**
