

ASSINIBOIA CURLING CLUB

There is seating along sheet one for approximately seven hundred spectators, while the main level lobby and lounge make room for another 300 viewers.

The lounge is located in the upper level of our curling club. There is excellent viewing for approximately 150 spectators. There is no problem seeing all curling action from anywhere behind the glass. The lounge also provides a billiards table, a shuffleboard table, and a big screen television for entertainment purposes following a game of curling.
